



RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT AND OUTCOMES COMMITTEE COMMISSION

General Commission:

The committee is responsible for developing the resources to meet the goals of the Texas Foreclosure Prevention Task Force (TFPTF) and measuring the progress of the Task Force compared to established desired outcomes.

Appointments and Composition:

1. Chair and Co-Chair will participate on the TFPTF Leadership Committee.
2. The Chair and Co-Chair will recruit however many people are needed to accomplish the committee commission.
3. Subcommittees may be formed as needed to accomplish the work of the committee. The Chairperson will appoint the chair of the subcommittee.

Responsibilities:

1. Become knowledgeable about the foreclosure issue and how it affects Texas families and communities and the mission, goals, accomplishments and impact of TFPTF.
2. Meet regularly as workload dictates.
3. Develop Budget to meet Task Force Goals and secure concurrence from Leadership Committee on Budget .
4. Construct Resource Development Plan and implement plan to include scale of gifts, strategy for lead gift(s), fundraising package and reports on progress toward meeting resource development goal/budget.
5. Develop and use a campaign tracking and reporting system, evaluate the progress of the campaign at regular intervals, and report to the Task Force membership.
