



STRATEGY COMMITTEE COMMISSION

General Commission:

The committee is responsible for understanding the scope and causes of the foreclosure issue in Texas and the impact on communities and families, identifying new strategies for addressing the causes and impact of foreclosure including utilization of federal resources and suggesting regulatory and legislative approaches.

Appointments and Composition:

1. Chair and Co-Chair will participate on the TFPTF Leadership Committee.
2. The Chair and Co-Chair will recruit however many people are needed to accomplish the committee commission.
3. Subcommittees may be formed as needed to accomplish the work of the committee. The Chairperson will appoint the chair of the subcommittee.

Responsibilities:

1. Become knowledgeable about the foreclosure issue and how it affects Texas families and communities and the mission, goals, accomplishments and impact of TFPTF.
2. Meet regularly as workload dictates.
3. Data collection and analysis
4. Compilation of strategies from other states
5. Examination of Texas common reasons for foreclosure in Texas and identification of potential intervention approaches both structural and behavioral.
6. Review of proposed federal legislation and analysis on what Texas needs to be done to be ready for potential resources should they materialize.
7. Recommendations for regulatory and legislative enhancements
8. Provide reports to TFPTF.
